2025 YEAR END AWARDS PROGRAM GENERAL RULES

Both the owner(s) and all exhibitor(s) of an animal must be members of the Pinto Horse Association of Ohio (PtHAO) in order for points to be counted for year-end awards. This rule applies to all divisions (open, amateur, youth,). Amateur exhibitors must hold a current PtHA amateur card in order to accumulate points for year-end awards. Exhibitors and owners need to be PtHA members in good standings.

Awards will be made to the owner or exhibitor of the animal.

1.) Points earned before membership is submitted will not count toward year end awards.

- 1) All Youth, Open, and Amateur Division year end awards will be based on the qualifying shows listed above.
- 2) Points for year-end awards may be accumulated in three divisions. The awards in each division are explained in the specific rules for that division. These divisions may be broken down further into sex/age categories at the discretion of PtHAO. These divisions are as follows:

Open, Amateur, Youth,

- 3) Points are as of when form and fee is paid. An animal may be entered into the program at any time during the show season.
- 4) Points earned in the Open, Youth, Amateur Divisions will be awarded according to the table below.
